Itinerary

Day 1 Arrive Vancouver

Welcome to Canada and the picturesque city of Vancouver. Check into your hotel, then the remainder of the day is free to start exploring.

Day 2 Free Day in Vancouver

Your time is free to explore at your leisure. This multicultural city offers something for everyone: big city buzz, sky-high mountains and Pacific beaches. If you're a history buff, you can view First Nations artefacts at the Museum of Anthropology. Explore old Chinatown and the famous collection of totem poles at Stanley Park. Meet over 50,000 aquatic creatures at the Vancouver Aquarium, or get a bird's eye view of the old-growth forest at Capilano Suspension Bridge Park. Horseshoe Bay salmon fishing, Granville Island paddle boarding, Grouse Mountain's aerial tram - discover loads of outdoor adventures in Vancouver, from the bay to the backwoods.

Day 3 Begin Royal Caribbean Alaska Glacier Cruise

Check out of your hotel in the morning. The day is free until it's time to make your way to Canada Place to board your 7-night Alaska cruise onboard Royal Caribbean's Enchantment of the Seas. Departure is 5pm.

Day 4 Inside passage, Canada - Cruising

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as you sail through the islands of Alaska's Inside Passage.

Home to diverse wildlife - orca, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters and more, the complex labyrinth of fjords and bays are where whales and sea lions find refuge during the summer months.

You'll never forget the sight of 40-ton whales hurling themselves into the air, almost completely escaping the water.

If you're especially lucky, you could see them swimming together to create a bubble net, trapping and eating fish by the giant mouthful.

Day 5 Sitka, Alaska, USA 9am - 6pm

Sitka truly offers the best of Alaska. Its small-town appeal stems from a unique blend of Russian, Tlingit and American history. Its snow-capped peaks and volcanic Mount Edgecumbe pose amongst the state's most postcard-worthy scenes.

The region's rare wildlife astounds, from Saint Lazaria Island's orange-beaked puffins to Alaska Maritime Refuge's 40 million seabirds.

This is off-the-beaten-track Alaska, where you can kayak Sitka Sound alongside swimming sea otters or fly-fish for the world's biggest halibut.

Whether it's hiking along Baranof Island trails or listening to tribal stories passed down for generations, in Sitka the midnight sun never sets on adventure.

Day 6 Juneau, Alaska, USA 7am - 9pm

You can't get to Juneau easily without a sprint by air or by sea. But once you arrive you'll find majestic views and rich culture in every corner.

With its snow-capped mountains, misty rainforests, massive glaciers and bounty of wildlife, Alaska's remote state capital is the perfect place to dive into nature.

Framed by Mount Juneau and Mount Roberts, the city's picturesque central area offers centuries-old bars, boutique shops and historical landmarks.

For a taste of the local culture, visit the historic district and the Alaska State Museum. And for outdoor thrills, you can take your pick of activities ranging from whale watching in Auke Bay Harbour to tundra trekking over Mendenhall Glacier, and even try your hand at gold panning in Last Chance Basin.

Day 7 Skagway, Alaska, USA 7am - 5pm - Haines, Alaska, USA 7pm-11.30pm

The tiny town of Skagway still looks like it did during the Klondike Gold Rush over 100 years ago - and today it remains an outpost for thrilling Alaskan adventure. An old-time tram ride along bustling Broadway Street reveals well-preserved buildings, including the state's oldest hotel.

You can see engraved walrus tusks at the Corrington Museum, or get lost in riveting historical re-enactments around town. If outdoor adventure is more your thing, there are plenty of ways to ramp up the adrenaline, from sledding with Alaskan Huskies on Laughton Glacier to rafting on Lynn Canal, the longest fjord in North America.

If you're looking for an authentic taste of wild, rugged adventure, a cruise to Haines, Alaska is just the ticket.

Located less than 70 miles north of Juneau, along the continent's longest and deepest fjord, Haines offers endless outdoor activities for intrepid explorers.

Hike deep into misty coastal rainforests and ancient spruce woodlands. Set out on a rafting adventure along the rivers that thread the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve. Learn about the gold rush era at Fort William H. Seward and discover the area's rich cultural heritage in museums dedicated to the Native Tlingit People.

Day 8 Tracy Arm Fjord, Alaska, USA 7am - 10am

Tracy Arm Fjord extends over 30 miles alongside the wilderness of Tongass National Forest. Sailing through this deep and narrow passage delivers some of the most breathtaking scenery you'll find in Alaska.

See active glaciers carved into 7,000-foot-tall mountain peaks and plunging waterfalls burrowed into evergreen-clad cliffs. Glimpse native wildlife and watch deep blue icebergs float past the ship.

On board Enchantment of the Seas

Enchantment of the Seas entered service in 1997, was refitted in 2017, and at 82,910 GT carries 2252 passengers. Enchantment of the Seas features about 8000 square metres of glass, her soaring seven-deck atrium, sculptures and artwork, and Royal Caribbean's signature Viking Crown Lounge atop the ship offering 180-degree views of the seascape.

The ship is family-friendly, with large facilities for children and teens. It caters for large conferences, Wi-Fi ship wide, wheelchair access, and also couples wishing to tie the knot in the wedding chapel. Though large, the ship offers a good passenger space ratio. Décor throughout is warm and attractive and there are plenty of public rooms, bars and lounges.

Though carrying over 2000 guests, dining, entertainment and activity centres are spread throughout the ship.

Please read the following information prior to making your reservation

Our full set of terms and conditions can be [viewed and downloaded on our website](#), or supplied on request from our office. We highly recommend you read My Travel Experience booking conditions prior to making your holiday reservations. This is the contract under which both parties enter, therefore we request that you only make a booking if you agree with these conditions.

This is a summary in brief for our customers:

1. Upon making a reservation with My Travel Experience you will receive a booking form, which needs to be filled out and signed to confirm that you agree to the terms and conditions.
2. Your booking will then be confirmed to you in writing and you will be required to make a payment to hold your reservation (amount will be advised upon confirmation).
3. At this time, you must take out travel insurance for your holiday to protect you against any unforeseen circumstances.
4. 90 days prior to departure you will be asked to make the balance payment for your trip (you will be notified if your supplier requires earlier payment).
5. 10 days prior to departure you will be sent your travel documents via email.

My Travel Experience operates a Client Trust bank account. This means that we do not hold your money. We pay the ultimate travel providers (Suppliers) of your travel services the funds for your holiday. The Suppliers include airlines, tour operators, cruise lines, transport companies, hotels etc. We are required to pay the Suppliers deposits and final payments to secure your booking and in some instances these items are non-refundable.

If you wish to cancel you must notify us of your cancellation in writing. We will then write to the Suppliers to cancel your booking and request a refund (if applicable) for any elements of your holiday that are refundable. You will need to make an insurance claim for any travel arrangements that are non-refundable. If you have any issues during the refund or cancellation process, you have 30 days to contact our office in writing to lodge a complaint so an immediate resolution can be found for you.
