Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrive Vancouver

Fly into Vancouver, Canada and make your own way to your downtown hotel. Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's most ethnically diverse cities. A popular filming location, it's surrounded by mountains, and also has thriving art, theatre and music scenes. Vancouver Art Gallery is known for its works by regional artists, while the Museum of Anthropology houses preeminent First Nations collections.

Day 2 (Vancouver To Kamloops - By Rocky Mountaineer Rail)

(Departs: 7:30 Am, Arrives: 5:35 Pm)*

Travel aboard the Rocky Mountaineer from the coastal city of Vancouver to the interior's largest city, Kamloops. On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery from the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coastal Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and snow sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake and into your overnight destination, Kamloops. [B] [L]

Day 3 (Kamloops To Jasper - By Rocky Mountaineer Rail)

(Departs: 8:10 Am, Arrives: 6:10 Pm)*

Your journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet), Pyramid Falls, as well as the climb over Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Your rail journey ends upon arrival in the town of Jasper this evening. Overnight in Jasper. [B] [L]

Day 4 (Jasper To Banff - By Coach)

(Departs: 8:30 Am, Arrives: 7:30 Pm)*

Start the morning with a refreshing hike in Maligne Canyon, one of the world's largest and deepest limestone gorges criss-crossed by 6 narrow bridges. Then head south on the Icefields Parkway to experience the thundering waters of Athabasca Falls, picturesque Peyto Lake, and majestic Castle Mountain. At the Columbia Icefield, ride the "Ice Explorer"** on Athabasca Glacier or visit the Glacier Skywalk*. Overnight in Banff. [B]

Day 5 (Banff National Park - By Coach)

(Departs: 8:00 Am, Arrives: 6:00 Pm)*

Enjoy scenic views, including the spectacular Lower Falls, as you walk through Johnston Canyon. At Lake Louise, stroll the shores of the glacier-fed lake and enjoy the atmosphere of the world-famous Chateau Lake Louise. Afternoon highlights include Moraine Lake, the Banff Springs Hotel, the Upper Hot Springs**, and views from the top of Sulphur Mountain**. Overnight in Lake Louise. [B]

Day 6 (Lake Louise To Vancouver - By Coach)

(Departs: 8:00 Am, Arrives: 7:30 Pm)*

Today you will head west crossing the Continental Divide and Rogers Pass, the highest pass in the Rockies. Learn about the Spiral Tunnels, a railroad engineering marvel. Relax and enjoy the passing scenery of Glacier National Park on your way back to Vancouver. [B] Overnight Vancouver.

Day 7 - Depart on Alaska Inside Passage Cruise

Today, make your way to Vancouver cruise port to check in for the Alaska Inside Passage Cruise on *Enchantment of Seas*.

Day 14 - Cruise arrives back in Vancouver

Your Alaska cruise arrives back in Vancouver this morning. Make your way to the airport by taxi for the flight to Las Vegas. On arrival, make your own way to the Luxor Hotel (or similar), where you'll be staying for 3 nights.

Day 15 - Free day Las Vegas

Lined with upscale casino hotels, the neon-soaked Strip is quintessential Las Vegas. As well as gambling floors, the vast hotel complexes house a variety of shops, restaurants (ranging from mainstream to high-end), and performance venues for music, comedy and circus-style acts. Attractions like the soaring, choreographed Fountains of Bellagio and the High Roller observation wheel draw crowds.

Day 16 - Grand Canyon Day tour.

The full-day tour begins when a professional driver picks up participants at their hotel. The air-conditioned bus takes passengers across the Hoover Dam and Lake Mead, stopping first in Kingman and Williams, Arizona, visiting the Grand Canyon Railway. Lunch is included before travelling to Grand Canyon National Park. Tours stop at the visitors' centre, then continue on to Mather Point, Yavapai Point and the destination with the most panoramic views, Bright Angel Point.

Day 17 - Depart Las Vegas for Australia

Please catch a taxi to Las Vegas airport for your flights home to Australia. We hope you have had a wonderful holiday.

Day 18 - Arrive Home in Australia.

Important to know

For the Canadian Rockies tour, the minimum group size is 25 and the maximum is up to 40 passengers per vehicle.

Optional activities include Columbia Icefield ‘Ice Explorer’ which is approx. CAD\$100 per person.

Activities are subject to availability, time permitting and weather conditions, and are payable direct to the tour operator in the currency specified.

- Some tours require minimum numbers to operate.
- Shore excursions can be booked/reserved directly with the cruise line prior to travel (subject to availability)
- Shore excursions can also be booked whilst onboard (subject to availability).

Gratuities/tipping:

While on tour: \$10 USD per person/day in total for driver and guide is recommended.

On the Cruise: Royal Caribbean charges a gratuity of US\$14.50 per person per day.

Guests staying in Grand Suites and above pay US\$17.50 per person per day.

On board Enchantment of the Seas

Enchantment of the Seas entered service in 1997, was refitted in 2017, and at 82,910 GT carries 2252 passengers. Enchantment of the Seas features about 8000 square metres of glass, her soaring seven-deck atrium, sculptures and artwork, and Royal Caribbean's signature Viking Crown Lounge atop the ship offering 180-degree views of the seascapes.

The ship is family-friendly, with large facilities for children and teens. It caters for large conferences, Wi-Fi ship wide, wheelchair access, and also couples wishing to tie the knot in the wedding chapel. Though large, the ship offers a good passenger space ratio. Décor throughout is warm and attractive and there are plenty of public rooms, bars and lounges.

Though carrying over 2000 guests, dining, entertainment and activity centres are spread throughout the ship.

4. 90 days prior to departure you will be asked to make the balance payment for your trip (you will be notified if your supplier requires earlier payment).
5. 10 days prior to departure you will be sent your travel documents via email.

We pay the ultimate travel providers (Suppliers) of your travel services the funds for your holiday. The Suppliers include airlines, tour operators, cruise lines, transport companies, hotels etc. We are required to pay the Suppliers deposits and final payments to secure your booking and in some instances these items are non-refundable.

If you wish to cancel you must notify us of your cancellation in writing. We will then write to the Suppliers to cancel your booking and request a refund (if applicable) for any elements of your holiday that are refundable. You will need to make an insurance claim for any travel arrangements that are non-refundable.
