Itinerary:

Day 1: London - Cambridge - Yorkshire

This unforgettable Europe and Great Britain tour begins today! Meet your tour leader and fellow travellers in London and get ready to travel through the scenic English countryside to Cambridge, a city famed for its impressive university.
