Follow a course of around 4465kms while you admire stunning views from the train and then explore the country's best destinations at extended stops.

Enjoy the comfort of a private cabin with Sleeper Plus amenities. There's on-board entertainment in the Skyline Car, which offers a library and lounge where drinks are served. Relax in the armchairs of the Bullet Lounge, and gaze at the views from the large wrap-around windows. Itinerary:

DAY 1, Fly to Canada, Arrive Vancouver

Fly into Vancouver, Canada and make your way to your downtown hotel. Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's densest, most ethnically diverse cities. A popular filming location, it's surrounded by mountains, and also has thriving art, theatre and music scenes. Vancouver Art Gallery is known for its works by regional artists, while the Museum of Anthropology houses preeminent First Nations collections. The remainder of the day is free to explore.

DAY 2, Vancouver

Enjoy more time to explore this great city, with its cultural districts, seaside points of interest and open spaces. Some of the major attractions you might like to visit include Canada Palace, Robson Street, Chinatown, Vancouver Aquarium, Stanley Park, Granville Island, Library Square, Parq Casino and Science World.

DAY 3, Board The Canadian Train

This train follows a course of approximately 2,775 miles, traversing through mountainscapes, lush evergreen forests, and wide-open prairies during its journey between Vancouver and Toronto. Along the way, VIA Rail's Canadian makes stops in cities and towns that highlight the country's diversity.

One of the most scenic stretches of the entire route is between Kamloops and Jasper, a resort town surrounded by Jasper National Park and the Rocky Mountains. The train travels along the Fraser River and offers a glimpse at Hell's Gate, a portion of the river that narrows rapidly, forcing the water to erupt at an incredible speed. The Canadian also joins the North Thompson River and offers views of Pyramid Falls and Mount Robson - the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies - before stationing in Jasper.

DAYS 4-6, The Canadian Train

Sleeper Plus offers the added comfort of amenities and great service. Inside the dining car, enjoy freshly cooked meals, regional specialties and a view that won't quit. The show continues inside the train with wine tastings, presentations, musical acts on certain departures, access to lounges and cars with glass ceilings.

DAY 7, Arrive in Toronto

After a spectacular cross-country rail journey, disembark in Toronto and make your way to the central hotel. Toronto is located on the shore of Lake Ontario and your time is free to start exploring this multicultural city.

DAY 8, Toronto

Today is free to discover Toronto's many highlights, like the impressive collection of modern skyscrapers, most notably, the CN Tower, one of the world's tallest free-standing structure (1,815 ft/553 m). Do you dare to stand on the glass floor located more than 300 meters above the city? You could also take an excursion on the St. Lawrence River, which explores the magnificent scenery on a relaxing cruise. Or take a trip to famous Niagara Falls, where you will be amazed at this natural wonder. Stroll along Table Rock, see the unique Floral Clock and view the thundering water of the Horseshoe Falls. Perhaps take an optional tour on the renowned Hornblower Niagara Cruise boat ride at the base of the Falls.

DAY 9, Depart Toronto

Sadly, today's the day to bid farewell to Canada. Check out of your hotel in the morning and make your way to the airport in time for your flights to Australia.

Please read the following information prior to making your reservation

Our full set of terms and conditions can be [viewed and downloaded on our website](#), or supplied on request from our office. This is the contract under which both parties enter, therefore we request that you only make a booking if you agree with these conditions.

This is a summary in brief for our customers:

1. Upon making a reservation with My Travel Experience you will receive a booking form, which needs to be filled out and signed to confirm that you agree to the terms and conditions.
2. Your booking will then be confirmed to you in writing and you will be required to pay a deposit to hold your reservation.
3. At this time, you must take out travel insurance for your holiday to protect you against any unforeseen circumstances.
4. 90 days prior to departure you will be asked to make the balance payment for your trip (the exact due date for your travel supplier will be advised at the time of booking).
5. 10 days prior to departure you will be sent your travel documents via email.

My Travel Experience operates a Client Trust bank account. This means that we do not hold your money. We pay the ultimate travel providers (Suppliers) of your travel services the funds for your holiday. The Suppliers include airlines, tour operators, cruise lines, transport companies, hotels etc. We are required to pay the Suppliers deposits and final payments to secure your booking and in some instances these items are non-refundable.

If you wish to cancel you must notify us of your cancellation in writing. We will then write to the Suppliers to cancel your booking and request a refund (if applicable) for any elements of your holiday that are refundable. You will need to make an insurance claim for any travel arrangements that are non-refundable. If you have any issues during the refund or cancellation process, you have 30 days to contact our office in writing to lodge a complaint so an immediate resolution can be found for you.
