14 May - Vancouver to Kamloops - by Rocky Mountaineer Rail

15 May - Kamloops to Jasper - by Rocky Mountaineer Rail

Today's highlights include Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet), Pyramid Falls, as well as the climb over Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. 16 May - Jasper to Banff - by Coach
