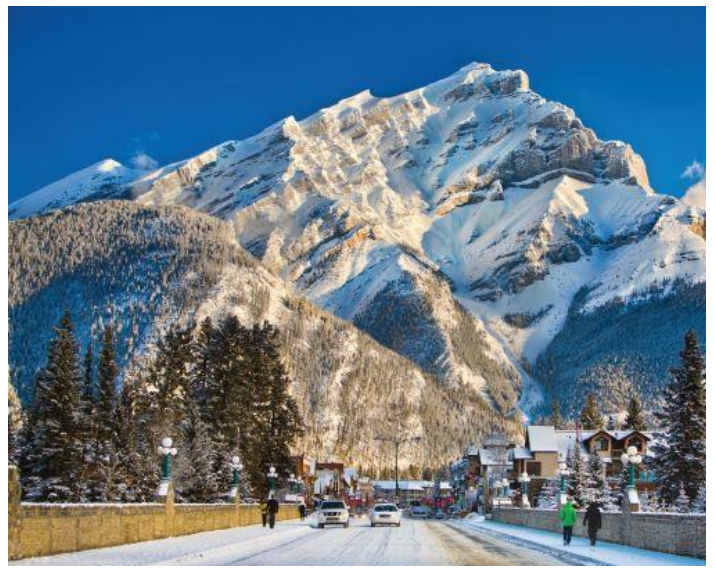

Itinerary:

DAY 1 ARRIVE VANCOUVER

Arrive Vancouver and make your way to the hotel by taxi for the next three nights. Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's densest, most ethnically diverse cities. A popular filming location, it's surrounded by mountains, and also has thriving art, theatre and music scenes. Vancouver Art Gallery is known for its works by regional artists, while the Museum of Anthropology houses preeminent First Nations collections.

DAY 2 VANCOUVER DAY TOUR

Hop-On, Hop-Off + Vancouver Lookout

Enhance Your Hop-On, Hop-Off bus tour experience with admission to the Vancouver Lookout. Explore the entire downtown area of Vancouver including Stanley Park, the Shopping District, Yaletown, Gastown and Granville Island! Included with your ticket is admission to the Vancouver Lookout. Get a 360-degree aerial view of Vancouver, 168 meters (553 feet) above the vibrant downtown core.

DAY 3 WHISTLER DAY TOUR

Have your camera ready to capture photos of bald eagles in Brackendale during this full-day journey to Whistler, via downtown Vancouver. Along the way, stop at Stanley Park and Horseshoe Bay, a quaint village at the entrance to Howe Sound. Your guide follows a scenic route along the Sea to Sky Highway to Shannon Falls, where you'll take a short hike, with time to explore the ski resort year-round. Guided day trip to the ski resort town of Whistler, round-trip from Vancouver Stops are made at the Brackendale Eagle Reserve and Horseshoe Bay Park Get up close to British Columbia's third-tallest waterfall: Shannon Falls

DAY 4 VANCOUVER - ON BOARD VIA RAIL

Check out of the hotel and store your luggage, then enjoy a free morning to explore Vancouver at your leisure. This afternoon, make your way to the station to board Via Rail's 'Canadian' Train for the overnight journey to the majestic Canadian Rocky Mountains. Feel like you've taken a trip back in time to the era of classic rail travel as you enjoy the comfort of your berth or cabin onboard. Wander through the train and enjoy the dome viewing carriage, and the delicious cuisine in the dining car. At night, onboard attendants will transform your quarters into cozy beds, ready for the rhythm of the rails to rock you to sleep. (D)

DAY 5 ON BOARD VIA RAIL - JASPER

By the time you awake this morning the train will be heading into the Canadian Rockies and Jasper. Enjoy breakfast while surrounded by dramatic scenery as the 'Canadian' begins its passage into the Rockies with views of snow-capped peaks, Pyramid Falls and the expansive glaciers of the Albretha Icefields.

Pass by Mount Robson, which at 3,954 m is the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Upon arrival in Jasper, the afternoon is yours to discover this charming mountain community. Make your way to the hotel for a two-night stay. (B)

DAY 6 JASPER

Experience the wonders of Maligne Canyon from the ground up! The canyon has withstood 10,000 years of erosion and has created a 50m gorge. Certified guides will lead groups of no more than 12 along the frozen canyon floor and its ice-clad limestone walls. Super soles and winter boots will keep you warm and secure while exploring this wonderland of rock and ice.

DAY 7 JASPER - LAKE LOUISE

Travel south along the Icefields Parkway to Lake Louise. This spectacular drive through glacier country features massive snow-covered mountains, frozen waterfalls and broad-reaching valleys. Spend the evening in Lake Louise where, if conditions permit, you can hire ice skates to take a spin around the frozen lake.

DAY 8 LAKE LOUISE - BANFF

Depart Lake Louise mid-morning for a short drive to Banff via the scenic Bow Valley. Banff National Park offers the quintessential winter wonderland experience. Whether your idea of being immersed in the Canadian Rockies is snowshoeing through snowy landscapes, soaking in hot springs, or cosying up by a fire with a decadent hot chocolate, Banff offers winter experiences for everyone. This afternoon, we've included a ticket for the Banff Gondola to take in stunning panoramic views of the Valley.

DAY 9 BANFF

It's a choose-your-own-adventure day today. Banff National Park offers many options for exploration and adventure. Wildlife lovers should join an expert guide to learn about the local flora and fauna, while a snowshoeing tour is a good option to explore the wintery landscape for those wanting to be a bit more active. For a classic winter experience, we'd also recommend joining a horse drawn sleigh ride.

DAY 10 BANFF - CALGARY

This morning is free to explore Banff, before your transfer to Calgary. Following the Trans Canada Highway, depart the Rocky Mountains to the Great Central Plains that roll to the east for 2,000 km and extend as far south as Mexico. This is 'cattle ranching country' and the breadbasket of Canada.

Please read the following information prior to making your reservation

Our full set of terms and conditions can be [viewed and downloaded on our website](#), or supplied on request from our office. 4. 90 days prior to departure you will be asked to make the balance payment for your trip (the exact due date for your travel supplier will be advised at the time of booking).
5. 10 days prior to departure you will be sent your travel documents via email.

We pay the ultimate travel providers (Suppliers) of your travel services the funds for your holiday. The Suppliers include airlines, tour operators, cruise lines, transport companies, hotels etc. We are required to pay the Suppliers deposits and final payments to secure your booking and in some instances these items are non-refundable.

If you wish to cancel you must notify us of your cancellation in writing. We will then write to the Suppliers to cancel your booking and request a refund (if applicable) for any elements of your holiday that are refundable.
