Itinerary:

DAY 1, Sunday - Depart for Morocco

Take off on your flights to Casablanca, Morocco

DAY 2, Monday - Arrive in Casablanca & Travel to Rabat

Arrive in Casablanca and make your way to the hotel in Rabat where you have the rest of the day at leisure to explore the capital city of Morocco. Your tour will begin with an orientation meeting with your Tour Manager at approximately 6 PM, followed by a light dinner. We recommend that you select flights arriving no later than 3 PM (*Note: transfer from Casablanca to Rabat can be pre-booked on request*)

Overnight: Rabat

Meals: Dinner

DAY 3, Tuesday - Rabat Sightseeing

This morning, take a city tour of Rabat. View the Royal Palace and the ancient ruins of Chellah, the Oudaya Kasbah, and the towering 12th century red sandstone Hassan Tower. Following lunch at a local restaurant, spend the afternoon at leisure

DAY 4, Wednesday - Volubilis en route to Fez

This morning, the dramatic well-preserved Roman ruins of Volubilis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, offers a unique glimpse into ancient Morocco. View a series of mansions, monuments and olive mills surrounded by remnants of the city's defence walls. The most notable highlights include the preserved Triumphal Arch of Caracalla, a series of mosaics and colourful tiles depicting Roman mythology. In the afternoon, depart for the imperial city of Fez. On arrival, check into your hotel. This evening, enjoy a special dinner hosted by a local family and learn about Moroccan culture and traditions*

**Home hosted dinner in Fez may be moved to another day, according to your host's availability*

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 5, Thursday - Fez City Tour

Begin the day with a city tour of Fez. Visit the many hidden treasures of the medina that only a Moroccan guide will know. Fez served as the capital of Morocco for more than 400 years and is home to the University of Al Karaouine. It is particularly famous for its tanneries and the Fes el Bali Medina. A short visit to the surrounding leather shops gives you the best view of the tanneries. View the Attarine Medersa, Moulay Idriss mausoleum, and visit the Nejjarine Fountains and Museum. Opportunities for shopping for authentic Moroccan carpets. Finally, view the exterior of the Royal Palace and walk through the famed Jewish Quarter of the medina where you will get a chance to walk through one of the few remaining Jewish cemeteries in Morocco

Overnight: Fez

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

DAY 6, Friday - Medina of Meknes, Wine Tasting en route to Casablanca

Today, discover the walled city of Meknes, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. View the monumental horseshoe-shape Bab Mansour gate, with its priceless mosaics, lavish tiles, and inscriptions. Afterward, it's on to lunch in the foothills of the Atlas Mountains at a vineyard with beautifully manicured gardens and traditional fountains. Linger for a wine tasting of their white and red wines. The drive then takes you to Casablanca, inspiration for the classic 1942 film

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

DAY 7, Saturday - Casablanca City Tour, Travel to Marrakesh

Begin the sightseeing tour of Casablanca, including the exterior of the Hassan II Mosque* and the beautiful Corniche seaside. Continue on a short drive through the residential areas of Casablanca to the city centre to visit the Mohamed V Square, the Habous quarter and the Notre Dame de Lourdes Cathedral. Later, depart Casablanca and head south to Marrakesh. Arrive and check into your hotel with time at leisure
**Hassan II Mosque is subject to unexpected closures for local religious observances.*

Meals: Breakfast

DAY 8, Sunday - Marrakesh City Tour

After breakfast, take a morning tour of the city. Visit the Saadian Tombs, dating back to the 16th century. Your tour also includes the Koutoubia Minaret, as well as the beautiful Bahia Palace. Finally, end the tour by walking through the medina before arriving at the Djemaa el Fna Square. Spend the afternoon at leisure, or join the *optional* Cooking Class with Carriage Ride. Participate in a cooking class and learn how to prepare traditional Moroccan tajine and salads. After dinner, take a horse-drawn carriage through Djemaa el Fna Square and the lively streets

Overnight: Marrakesh

Meals: Breakfast

DAY 9, Monday - Full Day in Marrakesh

Arise before dawn to participate in today's *optional* Hot Air Balloon Ride.* Take off in a hot air balloon as you watch the sunrise over Marrakesh. Drift above the beautiful landscape, before returning back to earth to enjoy a traditional Moroccan breakfast. Explore the city on your own today or perhaps join the *optional* tour to Essaouira,* whose medina is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an excellent example of a fortified North African town. Walk along the city's ramparts just north of Moulay Hassan Square where local artists sell their paintings. Continue on to the Skala de la Ville, which is a fortification built along the cliffs that defended the city from sea attacks. Explore the many souks in the medina, including the spice and jewelry souks. Visit a jewellery shop, renowned for its quality and design

Please read the following information prior to making your reservation

Our full set of terms and conditions can be [viewed and downloaded on our website](#), or supplied on request from our office. We highly recommend you read My Travel Experience booking conditions prior to making your holiday reservations. This is the contract under which both parties enter, therefore we request that you only make a booking if you agree with these conditions.

This is a summary in brief for our customers:

1. Upon making a reservation with My Travel Experience you will receive a booking form, which needs to be filled out and signed to confirm that you agree to the terms and conditions.
2. Your booking will then be confirmed to you in writing and you will be required to pay a deposit to hold your reservation.
3. At this time, you must take out travel insurance for your holiday to protect you against any unforeseen circumstances.
4. 90 days prior to departure you will be asked to make the balance payment for your trip (the exact due date for your travel supplier will be advised at the time of booking).
5. 10 days prior to departure you will be sent your travel documents via email.

My Travel Experience operates a Client Trust bank account. This means that we do not hold your money. We pay the ultimate travel providers (Suppliers) of your travel services the funds for your holiday. The Suppliers include airlines, tour operators, cruise lines, transport companies, hotels etc. We are required to pay the Suppliers deposits and final payments to secure your booking and in some instances these items are non-refundable.

If you wish to cancel you must notify us of your cancellation in writing. We will then write to the Suppliers to cancel your booking and request a refund (if applicable) for any elements of your holiday that are refundable. You will need to make an insurance claim for any travel arrangements that are non-refundable. If you have any issues during the refund or cancellation process, you have 30 days to contact our office in writing to lodge a complaint so an immediate resolution can be found for you.
