DAY 1, Saturday - Depart for Portugal

DAY 2, Sunday - Arrive in Lisbon

Arrive in Portugal's capital city, Lisbon, and catch taxi to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Your tour will begin with an orientation meeting with your Tour Manager at the hotel at approximately 6 PM. We recommend that you select flights which arrive no later than 4 PM **Overnight:** Lisbon

DAY 3, Monday - Lisbon City Tour

Begin the tour of Lisbon with a stop at the top of Edward VII's Park to enjoy panoramic views over the hills of Lisbon and the River Tagus. Next, view the treasured 16th century Belem Tower, a monument to Portugal's Age of Discovery and UNESCO World Heritage Site. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. Tonight, attend the *optional* Fado Dinner. While dining, listen to the popular performances of local songs accompanied by guitar playing Portuguese melodies. Savour dinner with wine before a brief drive through the illuminated city **Optional:** Fado Dinner **Overnight:** Lisbon **Meals:** Breakfast

DAY 4, Tuesday - Obidos en route to Porto/Afurada, Cruise Embarkation

This morning, depart Lisbon and begin a lovely drive to Porto; you will embark the ship in Afurada, a charming place outside Porto. Along the way, stop at the medieval town of Obidos, encircled by fortified walls for lunch on your own. Spend free time to explore the town with its many Gothic and Renaissance churches, before continuing to Porto. Arrive at the port for embarkation. After arrival formalities, time to relax on board. DAY 5, Wednesday - Sail to Regua, Douro Museum

This morning, sail along the Douro towards Regua. This historic town in the heart of Portugal's most famous wine region, has been the centre of port wine industry for centuries. After a light lunch, disembark and visit the Douro Museum, housed in a restored former wine warehouse, learn about the wine making industry of the area. Stroll through the exhibits providing information on the history of the Douro region, including the geography, climate and people. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure or participate in the *optional* tour to a renowned wine estate. Visit the vineyard and learn about Porto and red wine production, aging, and bottling. The ship docks overnight in Regua **Optional:** Half Day Winery Tour & Tasting **Overnight:** River Cruise **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 6, Thursday - Castelo Rodrigo

This morning sail towards Pocinho. After lunch, disembark in Pocinho and transfer to the medieval village of Castelo Rodrigo, perched on a hilltop and surrounded by imposing walls. Stroll along the steep narrow cobblestone alleys and learn about its fascinating history. You may also choose to stay onboard and continue cruising. Re-join the ship late this afternoon in Vega de Terrón, where it overnights **Overnight:** River Cruise

DAY 7, Friday - Explore Salamanca

After an early breakfast, embark on a full day excursion to Salamanca, Spain. Travel through the Spanish countryside to Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. View ancient sandstone buildings, Plaza Mayor, the Clergy, the striking 12th century old Cathedral with its mysterious carvings, Casa de las Conchas, and the historic centre of the city. The tour ends at Ribeira Quarter with free time to shop for souvenirs. Afterward head back to the ship **Overnight:** River Cruise

View and learn about the Palace of the Dukes of Braganza. End the tour at the historical main square Oliveira and spend some free time before returning to the ship **Optional:** Medieval City of Guimarães **Overnight:** River Cruise

DAY 11, Tuesday - Disembarkation, Visit Aveiro

This morning, disembark and head to Aveiro, a charming coastal city known as the "Venice of Portugal." The city features picturesque canals, colourful moliceiro boats and rich cultural heritage. The guided tour will take you through Aveiro's highlights, allowing you to immerse yourself in the city's unique ambience. Savour a delightful lunch at a local restaurant. Afterward, return to Porto and check into your hotel. Free time to discover Porto's vibrant nightlife on your own **Overnight:** Porto

DAY 12, Wednesday - Full Day in Porto

Spend the day at leisure in Porto. Perhaps, join the full day *optional* Braga & Barcelos tour. Soak up the rich history and vibrant culture of these two cities. Visit the historic city of Braga, often referred to as the "Rome of Portugal." The city has over 2,000 years of history and a lot of ancient Roman influence. Then, head to Barcelos, a city famous for its pottery and folklore. Discover the legend of the Barcelos Rooster an emblematic symbol of Portugal and explore the historic centre with its medieval castle ruins and charming squares. Later, enjoy the scenic drive back to Porto **Optional:** Full Day Braga & Barcelos Tour **Overnight:** Porto **Meals:** Breakfast

DAY 13, Tuesday - Depart Portugal

After breakfast it's time to check out of the hotel and make your own way to the airport by taxi for your departure flight to Australia Meals: Breakfast

My Know before you book - High & low water levels

European river cruising has gained in popularity for very good reason. It's a relaxing and convenient way to experience Europe while enjoying the comfort of a deluxe ship. However, before making the decision to reserve your vacation, please be aware of potential conditions which may impact your cruise.

While most of the time river cruises operate exactly as planned, weather conditions may result in high or low water levels which impact a ship's itinerary and, on occasion, render a ship unable to sail at all. On very rare occasions, other events such as heavy fog, a damaged lock, or an incapacitated vessel blocking the river, may impact a sailing. These events typically occur with little or no notice. In the event that a cruise is partially or completely impacted, the itinerary will be operated by deluxe motor coach, accompanied by a Tour Manager, with overnights in hotels. When the option exists, the operator will "swap ships" with another vessel sailing in the opposite direction, retaining the sailing experience. Crew, ship and cabin configuration may differ. The itinerary will include as many of the originally scheduled sightseeing features as possible, considering the travel time and distances required, as well as meals.

While it is not possible to recreate the more leisurely comforts of sailings, the tour operator will endeavour to provide a comparable itinerary. These alternative services will be provided at no additional charge.
