Day 1 - Depart Australia Today, board your flights to Dublin in Ireland

Day 2 - Arrive in Dublin

Arrive in Dublin, where you'll be met and transferred to your hotel on the outskirts of the city for a two-night stay. Includes Dinner

The jaunting car rambles its way along Killarney National Park, Deer Park and on to Ross Castle on the shores of Lough Leane.

Day 6 - Galway
