Itinerary:

Day 1: 🏕 Hanoi Arrival

Today, depart Australia for Hanoi - the Capital of Vietnam. Upon arrival to the airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in **Accommodation:** Chalcedony Hotel 4* or similar

Note: Sydney might departure one day earlier. The hotel is not included and you might pre-book with the extra cost (AUD110/room/night)

Day 2: Hanoi City tour 🖵 Halong 🚈

After breakfast, at 10AM, you will have a bustling day to visit a city tour of Hanoi and will explore attractions such as the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university, Ho Chi Minh Complex (Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, One Pillar Pagoda) and Tran Quoc Pagoda, one of the oldest pagodas in Vietnam. In the afternoon, leave the bustle of the big city and drive to Halong Bay. On arrive in Tuan Chau Island, check in your hotel and free time at leisure or you might buy an optional tour such as Dinner on Halong Bay Cruise Tour.

In the evening, you will enjoy a classy and sophisticated buffet dining experience with more than 100 European - Asian delicacies and fresh seafood in the heritage bay. The unique experience is elevated to the next level with top-notch entertainment with an exclusive spectacle and state-of-the-art visual effects.

Day 03: Halong Bay Cruise 🖵 Hanoi

Today enjoy a day cruise on Halong Bay: a UNESCO World Heritage Site and natural wonderland composed of jutting limestone islands and sparkling turquoise waters, located in the Gulf of Tonkin. After breakfast at the hotel, drive to the Halong harbor to board your private junk cruise for a 4-hour journey. Cruise along the calm waters, between looming, limestone outcrops to visit Dau Go Cave, where in 1288 one of Vietnam's most famous generals, Tran Hung Dao, stored hundreds of stakes before battling the invading Mongolian army. A short walk away, visit the newly discovered Thien Cung, famous for its stalagmites and stalactites. Savour a fresh seafood lunch, served on board before sailing back to Tuan Chau harbour, where your transport will be waiting to take you back to Hanoi. This evening, you are free or can book a Street Tour optional with us.

Optional Hanoi Street Food (Dinner included)

Enjoy a walk around the Old Quarter in the afternoon and appreciate the local lifestyles as you wind through Hanoi's streets. You will have a taste of Northern Vietnamese delicacies such as: Stuffed pancake, banh my, stuffed sticky rice balls, the unique egg coffee and many more.

Day 4: Hanoi <table-cell-rows> Flight to Danang 🖵 Hoi An Ancient Town

Enjoy your free time in the morning before you will leave Hanoi for flight to Danang. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the UNESCO World Heritage listed town of Hoi An. After that, you will explore Hoi An on foot, visiting an old merchant's home, Hoi An Market, a local Chinese temple and the Japanese Covered Bridge. The bridge was first constructed here in the 1590s by the Japanese community to link them with the Chinese quarters. Over the centuries the ornamentation has remained relatively faithful to the original Japanese design. The French flattened out the roadway for cars, but the original arched shape was restored in 1986.

Day 05: Hoi An

Today you can enjoy a day of leisure to explore Hoi An or join our optional tours to Golden Bridge in Ba Na Hills.

Optional Golden Bridge Tour

The trip starts when our guide & car driver pick you up for the transfer. On arrival at the Ba Na mountain foot, we'll travel by cable car up to the Marseille station. Get out and take a short walk to the Golden Bridge - a break point of the trip - to feel like walking on the clouds. Just newly opened to the public in early June 2018 the bridge which was built in the midst of the forest stands out in yellow. Noteworthy, this unique architecture with the bridge image supported by grey hands, creates a beautiful scenery surprised. Time for taking photos and enjoying the easy breeze, breathtaking view and afterwards, we'll walk further to a romantic flower garden - Le Jardin D'Amour. The 9 gardens are 9 interesting stories in 9 unique architectural styles. These create a poetic and colourful space. Next, walk to visit Linh Ung Pagoda to admire its sophisticated architecture together with a 27m high Shakyamuni statue which brings us peaceful feeling as visiting this place. Finally, we'll catch the cable car downhill and then transfer to Hoi An.

Featuring 500 performers with superb choreography, this open-air theatrical extravaganza tells a story about Hoi An throughout 400 years of history while shining the spotlight on Ao Dai and the hidden charming beauty of Vietnamese women.

Day 06: Hoi An

Today, you are free or you can buy optional tours we suggest below: Meal: Breakfast Accommodation: Hoi An Rosemary Boutique Hotel 4* or similar

Optional My Son Sanctuary and Thanh Ha Village Tour

My Son sanctuary, a great sample of ancient Champa civilization situated in the southern region of Vietnam. Stand astounded by a great number of exquisite stone sculptures, temples and towers nestled in a tropical jungle.

Day 07: Hoi An 🛱 Da Nang <table-cell-rows> Flight to Ho Chi Minh City

After breakfast, you will have your free time before transferred to the airport for the flight to Ho Chi Minh City.

Upon arrival, enjoy an orientation tour through Ho Chi Minh City's bustling streets en route to the hotel. Have lunch at your own and visit the War Remnants Museum, learn about Vietnam's recent history at Reunification Palace, visit the nearby neo-Romanesque Notre Dame Cathedral and the City's Centre Post Office before passing by the ornate Opera Theatre and the City Hall. Finally, end up at the Ben Thanh Market, where vendors display a vast array of goods and handicrafts. **Meals:** Breakfast

Optional Dinner on Saigon River Cruise

Dinner on Saigon River Cruise offers an opportunity to witness another side of Saigon. The city is not only a bustling metropolis but also a romantic land. Hop on a huge wooden barge and sail down the river. Feel the gentle breeze caressing your skin and enjoy a lovely dinner accompanied by the traditional music and dance performances.

Day 08: Ho Chi Minh City 🖵 Optional tour to Mekong Delta

Embark on a cruise to Ben Tre river and visit brickwork, coconut processing workshop, a local village making sleep mattresses. Continue taking a motor cart (xe lôi) or cycling through the green rice fields and vegetable plains. Lunch is served at the restaurant riverside. In the afternoon, sail through water palm creek by rowboat and get back to Hung Vuong Pier for departing to Saigon.

Optional Vespa Adventure - Saigon After Dark Tour

Discover Saigon's nightlife on the back of a vintage Vespa scooter. Enjoy your amazing night by whisking away the city and stop by some shops to taste Saigon's best authentic local food.

Day 09: Ho Chi Minh City 🛱 Cu Chi Tunnels - Departure Australia 📌

You are free at leisure in the morning.

Check out at your hotel and then visit Cu Chi Tunnels in the afternoon. Explore Cu Chi tunnels. During the Vietnam War, guerrilla fighters built a labyrinth of narrow tunnels, using them to hide in during bombing raids and to stage surprise attacks. Today, the remaining tunnels have become a major tourist attraction, giving visitors a unique understanding of what life was like during the Vietnam War.

Late afternoon, we drive you to the airport for flight back home. Overnight on Plane. **Meal:** Breakfast

Day 10: Home Arrival Arrive home today.

The passport must be valid for a minimum of six months from the intended date of return and must have more than 2 blank pages.

Children must be 2 years old or over and share a room with parents at all times. Children are the same price as adults.
