Day 9: Bucharest, Munich (By Flight)

Are you ready to say goodbye to Romania and fly to Munich, Germany's third-largest city? Munich is known for its rich cultural heritage, stunning architecture, and world-famous Oktoberfest. Upon arrival enjoy some free time to explore the city's famous landmarks, including Marienplatz, the Viktualienmarkt, and the Englischer Garten.

Day 11: Munich-Salzburg

In the late afternoon, visit the atmospheric Christmas market in Cathedral Square, where the smells of gluehwein, roasted chestnuts, toasted almonds and cinnamon brushed baked apples waft through the marketplace and traditional Salzburg choirs fill the air. Later on, jump in to a cable car and reach the Hohensalzburg Fortress, the city's most visible landmark. This fully preserved castle hosts a small, intimate Christmas market and if you're lucky, Christmas themed live music.

Day 12: Salzburg
