Itinerary:

DAY 1 Sunday 2 March 2025 - Depart Australia

We depart Australia today on our flights to South Africa.

DAY 2 Monday 3 March 2025 - Fly Johannesburg to Victoria Falls

On our arrival into Johannesburg airport this morning, transfer to our connecting flight to Victoria Falls Airport. On arrival we are transferred to Hwange National Park and our Safari Lodge. Named after a local Nhanzwa chief, Hwange National Park is the largest Park in Zimbabwe, occupying roughly 14,650 square kilometers. It is located in the northwest corner of the country about one hour south of the mighty Victoria Falls. It became the royal hunting grounds to the Ndebele warrior-king Mzilikazi in the early 19th century and was set aside as a National Park in 1929. Hwange boasts a tremendous selection of wildlife with over 100 species of mammals and nearly 400 bird species recorded. The elephants of Hwange are world famous and the Park's elephant population is one of the largest in the world.

DAY 3 Tuesday 4 March 2025 - Hwange National Park

Today we have our first safari at Hwange National Park. We will hopefully see the 'Big 5' - Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Buffalo. We'll also see many varieties of colourful birds. Our experienced guide will help us spot hard-to see animals, so we make the most of the safari.

DAY 4 Wednesday 5 March 2025 - Hwange National Park

Our second day on safari in the Hwange National Park is sure to be another day of great wildlife sightseeing and memorable experiences. The afternoon is free to relax.

DAY 5 Thursday 6 March 2025 - Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

This morning we travel to Victoria Falls and enjoy a sightseeing tour. Victoria Falls are among the most spectacular waterfalls in the world. The Zambezi River, which is more than 2 km wide at this point, plunges noisily down a series of basalt gorges and raises an iridescent mist that can be seen more than 20 km away. A great day to experience one of the major natural wonders of the world.

DAY 6 Friday 7 March 2025 - Victoria Falls

Today is a free day to explore the Victoria Falls area.

DAY 7 Saturday 8 March 2025 - Victoria Falls

A free day to explore the Falls area. Perhaps try riding the rapids down the Zambezi River or a helicopter flight over the falls.

DAY 8 Sunday 9 March 2025 - Fly to Cape Town

Today we fly to the City of Cape Town, South Africa. Known as the “Mother City”, Cape Town is the oldest city in South Africa. Perched between the ocean and Table Mountain, with a national park as its heart, there is nowhere like Cape Town. On arrival we will be transferred to our hotel.

DAY 9 Monday 10 March 2025 - Cape Town Tour

Today we enjoy a sightseeing tour to see many fabulous sights such as the imposing brick and stucco Houses of Parliament, the Victoria and Alfred dock area, and the Bo-Kaap area, where the Cape Malays live in brightly-coloured cube houses dating from the 18th and 19th centuries. We take the cable car up Table Mountain for wonderful views of Table Bay, the city and the sea (weather permitting).

DAY 10 Tuesday 11 March 2025 - Cape Town

Today is a free day to enjoy Cape Town. You might wish to take a full day tour to the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point, the most southwesterly tip of Africa.

DAY 11 Wednesday 12 March 2025 - MSC Cruise Embarkation

Today we are transferred to the port to board the MSC Musica for our cruise up the west coast to Namibia.

DAY 12 Thursday 13 March 2025 - At Sea

A free day to enjoy the facilities of the ship.

DAY 13 Friday 14 March 2025 - Walvis Bay, Namibia

Walvis Bay is a small port on the Skeleton Coast of Namibia and the gateway to the Namib Desert. Sheltered by the Pelican Point sand spit, its tidal lagoon is home to abundant birdlife including flamingos, pelicans and Damara terns. The harbour is busy with fishing boats and ships. Dolphins, whales and Cape fur seals inhabit the Atlantic waters around the Pelican Point Lighthouse. Take a tour into the desert or explore the curio markets, craft shops, art galleries, museums and the beachfront.

DAY 14 Saturday 15 March 2025 - At Sea

A free day to enjoy the facilities of the ship. Perhaps take a dance class or just relax by the pool.

DAY 15 Sunday 16 March 2025 - Disembarkation Cape Town

After disembarking the MSC Musica, we are transferred to our hotel. The rest of the day is free.

DAY 16 Monday 17 March 2025 - Fly to Australia

This morning we are transferred to the airport for our flights back to Australia
