

11 to 13 May - Free Days in Vancouver

Enjoy three free days to explore Vancouver at leisure. Overnight at the Moda Hotel (or similar) for 3 nights. On your scenic return journey through Yoho National Park, catch a glimpse of an engineering marvel: the Spiral Tunnels. Arrive in downtown Vancouver in the evening. Overnight Moda Hotel Vancouver (or similar).
