### **DAY 2: Arrive in Oslo, Norway**

Arrive in Oslo and catch a taxi from the airport to your hotel to check in. The remainder of the day is yours to relax at your hotel or set out to explore Norway's capital.

Make your own way to Oslo airport by taxi or shuttle and fly to Iceland. Arrive in Reykjavik, the world's most northerly capital, surrounded by incredible landscapes and countless natural wonders. Catch a taxi from the airport to your hotel. Stay in this amazing city for 7 nights. Remainder of the day is free for you to explore at leisure.

## **DAY 6: Reykjavik Walking Tour**

Today's sightseeing takes you on foot around the heart of downtown Reykjavík to the main attractions, such as Harpa concert hall, Parliament building, City Hall and more. The main focus of this walking tour is the general history of Iceland and the evolution of Reykjavík as a town as well as stories of elves, vikings, food, nightlife, music, economic aspects and political affairs. Finally, there are the funny facts about Iceland and the places you must see in Reykjavík. The walk itself is easy, about 2km long (1.3 miles) and lasts **2 hours**. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore at your leisure and maybe retrace your steps to places you'd like to explore.

## **DAY 7: Reykjavik Hop On Hop Off Bus Tour**

Explore the best of Reykjavik on a flexible hop-on, hop-off tour today. Witness the famous landmarks and attractions of this modern city and admire the stunning scenery of the surrounding mountains and the ocean. Board your hop-on, hop-off bus at any of the conveniently located stops, hop off for whale spotting or visit the museum, and hop back on when you're ready. ## **DAYS 8 & 9: Northern Lights Tours**

The days are free to enjoy your time in Reykjavik, then each evening you can join the Northern Lights tours. The three-hour long Northern Lights tour will take you out of the city for the best possible view of the lights. The northern lights, also known as aurora borealis, are caused by the interaction of particles from the sun with the upper atmosphere near the North Pole.

The locations visited during the Northern Lights tour vary from day to day depending on weather conditions. Because this tour is weather dependent, sightings are not guaranteed. However, if you do not see any northern lights during this tour, you are welcome to join the tour again, free of charge. Indicated return times may vary if the activity is good.

*Please note, Northern Lights tours may operate on other nights during your stay. Aurora Borealis is subject to correct weather conditions and sightings cannot be guaranteed. If the tour is cancelled locally, another Northern Lights tour will be offered on an alternate evening. The Reykjavik Northern Lights tour departs at approximately 9 pm-10pm and the tour may not return until after midnight.*

### **DAYS 10 & 11: Reykjavik Free Days**

Spend time enjoying Reykjavik, or take the opportunity to discover more of Iceland and add a tour to the famous Lava Tunnel, the scenic South Shore that's renowned for gorgeous Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls, or the magical Blue Lagoon.

It's time to catch a taxi to the airport for your flight to Copenhagen. On arrival, catch the train to your city hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure.
