DAY 1: Depart Australia on flights to England.

DAY 2: Arrive London

Visit Jedburgh: Visit this picturesque Scottish border town and enjoy some free time to explore. The pretty Royal Borough is home to beautiful sights and architecture. A visit to the Jedburgh Abbey ruins is highly recommended!

Orientation tour of Edinburgh: Join your tour leader as they take you on a driving and walking tour through Edinburgh. DAY 5: Edinburgh: Free Day

Take a step back in time, and wander around the unchanged cobbled streets of the Royal Mile. If there are clear skies, hike up to Arthur's Seat for some incredible views. DAY 7: Gretna Green - Lake District - Liverpool
